AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and

Recreation Department; amending 74 O.S. 1991,
Section 1831, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 368,
O.S.L. 1992 (74 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 1831),
which relates to merchandise for resale in
Department retail outlets; and modifying statutory
reference.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1831, as
amended by Section 8, Chapter 368, O.S.L. 1992 (74 O.S. Supp. 1992,
Section 1831), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1831. Merchandise for resale purchased for and sold in
Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department retail outlets such as
golf course pro shops, marinas, restaurants, and other support
facilities which are necessary for the efficient and economical
operation of Department operated facilities and programs, is exempt
from the Central Purchasing Act, Section 85.1 et seq. of this title.
Services of writers, artists, photographers or others involved in
the artistic production of Oklahoma Today Magazine shall also be
exempt from the Central Purchasing Act.
