AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 377.1, which relates
to the Department of Public Safety Communications
Division; modifying references; directing certain
employees work for certain authority; eliminating
certain positions; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 377.1, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 377.1 ~~(a)~~ A. There is hereby established in the
Department of Public Safety a division to be known as the Department
of Public Safety Communications Division. This division shall be
divided into a Dispatchers Bureau and a Technicians Bureau and such
other bureaus as the Commissioner may direct.

~~(b)~~ B. In order to be eligible for employment to the positions
of ~~Director of the Communications Division,~~ Communications Officer,
Radio Technician, Radio Dispatcher and Tower Maintenance Officer
included in the Public Safety Communications Division, a person
shall be a citizen of Oklahoma; shall be of good moral character;
shall possess a high school education or the equivalent thereof; and
shall pass such physical and mental examinations as the Commissioner
may prescribe.

C. All employees of the Department of Public Safety
Communications Division shall be assigned to work under the

authority of a Troop Commander. The existing positions of Zone
Coordinator and Director of the Communications Division shall be
eliminated on the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1993.
