AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 851, which relates to safety inspection stickers; modifying statutory references; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 851, is amended to read as follows:

Section 851. No person shall drive or move on any highway any motor vehicle, including motorcycles, trailers, semitrailers or pole trailers, or ancient vehicles which are not used primarily incidental to historical or exhibition purposes only or which have been modified from their original state of manufacture by changes or modifications to the engine and/or chassis, which are licensed by the Oklahoma Tax Commission and operated on the streets or highways of this state or any combination thereof, unless the equipment upon any and every said vehicle is in good working order and adjustment as required in Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes and is in such safe mechanical condition as not to endanger the driver or other occupant of any vehicle upon the highway. Each such motor vehicle, except any commercial truck or truck-tractor registered pursuant to Section 1120 of this title which is engaged in interstate commerce, or any trailer or semitrailer registered pursuant to Section 1133 of this title which is engaged in interstate commerce, shall bear an official inspection sticker.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to any manufactured home which requires a permit to be moved upon the highways of this state; nor shall the provisions of this section apply to any ancient vehicle as defined by Section 39.1 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, which has not been modified from its original state of manufacture. Provided that ancient vehicles shall be exempt from retrofitted pollution control devices.

Nothing in this section shall exempt any motor vehicle from the provisions of the Oklahoma Motor Carrier Safety and Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, Section 230.1 et seq. of this title.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
