

SHORT TITLE: Waste and the environment; modifying fee for disposal of liquid waste in underground injection wells; emergency.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to waste and the environment;

amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-2005.3B, as amended by Section 16, Chapter 403, O.S.L. 1992 (63 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 1-2005.3B), which relates to disposal fees for liquid waste in underground injection wells; modifying disposal fee; requiring annual payment of fee; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 1-2005.3B, as amended by Section 16, Chapter 403, O.S.L. 1992 (63 O.S. Supp. 1992, Section 1-2005.3B), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-2005.3B. Any person subject to regulation under this title disposing of liquid waste other than hazardous waste in an underground injection well shall pay a fee ~~of one-tenth of one cent (\$0.001) per gallon for such disposal, not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)~~ Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per year. ~~Said fee shall be paid to the Department on a quarterly basis within one month following the close of each quarter for the waste disposed in that preceding quarter.~~ Said ~~fees~~ fee shall be paid on an annual basis as required by the Department and deposited into the Public Health Special Fund.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
