AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring district board of education to make certain allocations from general fund for band and cheerleading squad; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-154 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Except as otherwise provided in this section any district board of education that provides uniforms or equipment for athletic training and competition and pays for athletic uniforms or athletic equipment from the district's general fund must allocate from the general fund equal amounts for school band uniforms and equipment and cheerleading squad uniforms and equipment. If band and cheerleading squad uniforms and equipment equivalent to uniforms and equipment provided for athletic competition and training can be provided for a lesser amount, the district may allocate the lesser amount.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
