

SHORT TITLE: Nonintoxicating beverages; prohibiting sale during certain times; prohibiting sale through drive-thru windows; codification; effective date.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; prohibiting sale of certain nonintoxicating beverages at certain times; prohibiting sale of certain nonintoxicating beverages through drive-thru windows; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.26 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

From and after the effective date of this act, it shall be unlawful for any place licensed to sell nonintoxicating beverages as defined in paragraph (a) of Section 163.2 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for off-premises consumption, to sell such beverages between the hours of twelve o'clock a.m. and six o'clock a.m. of the same day.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.27 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

From and after the effective date of this act, it shall be unlawful for any place licensed to sell nonintoxicating beverages as defined in paragraph (a) of Section 163.2 of Title 37 of the

Oklahoma Statutes, for off-premises consumption, to sell such beverages through or at a drive-thru window.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
