AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Grand River Dam Authority;
requiring Authority to maintain certain reserve of
coal; providing for codification; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 862.1 of Title 82, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Grand River Dam Authority shall hereby be required to
maintain at all times, except times of extreme demand or crisis, a
reserve of generating capacity equal to ten percent (10%) of their
total generating capacity or such other amount in excess of ten
percent (10%) as required by power pool of which the Grand River Dam
Authority may be a member.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
