AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to various law enforcement agencies;
limiting the expenditure of appropriated funds by
the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
limiting the salary of the Director; providing
budgetary limitations; limiting the expenditure of
appropriated funds by the Council on Law
Enforcement Education and Training; providing for
duties and compensation of employees; limiting the
salary of the Director; providing budgetary
limitations; limiting the expenditure of
appropriated funds by the Oklahoma State Bureau of
Investigation; providing for duties and
compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
Director; providing budgetary limitations;
providing for certain unclassified positions;
limiting the expenditure of appropriated funds by
the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and
Dangerous Drugs Control; providing for duties and
compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
Director; providing budgetary limitations; limiting
the expenditure of appropriated funds by the
Department of Public Safety; providing for duties
and compensation of employees; providing budgetary

limitations; excluding certain personnel from
limitation on full-time-equivalent employees;
limiting the expenditure of appropriated funds by
the Board of Medicolegal Investigations; providing
for duties and compensation of employees; limiting
the salary of the Chief Medical Examiner; providing
budgetary limitations; providing an operative date;
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$52,269.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

COUNCIL ON LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATION AND TRAINING

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty-three Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$43,475.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OKLAHOMA STATE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-seven Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$57,050.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. One (1) Information Representative, one (1) Legal Officer and one (1) Special Investigator shall be unclassified positions. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OKLAHOMA STATE BUREAU OF NARCOTICS AND DANGEROUS DRUGS CONTROL

SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-four Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-

four Dollars (\$54,384.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except hours coded as overtime wages, and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the Director. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, except the full-time-equivalent employee limit shall not include cadets while they are members of a patrol school or during their employment in probationary status nor shall it include temporary Lake Patrol Officers employed pursuant to Section 840.8 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, excluding expenditures for capital and

special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

MEDICOLEGAL INVESTIGATIONS

SECTION 6. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not exceed Ninety-two Thousand One Hundred Nine Dollars (\$92,109.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
