

SHORT TITLE: Bonds; redesignating the appropriation of certain bond proceeds to the Department of Agriculture; emergency.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to appropriations to the State

Department of Agriculture; redesignating certain funds; restricting expenditure of funds to specified purposes; requiring certain budget submittals; requiring legislative appropriation of certain funds; restricting transfer of funds; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION In accordance with the provisions of Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution and Section 57.303 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the amount of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) appropriated by Section 77, Chapter 189, O.S.L. 1993, to the State Department of Agriculture from the proceeds of the sale of bonds deposited in the Oklahoma Building Bonds of 1992 Fund (A) in the State Treasury, for the purpose of dry fire hydrants is hereby redesignated for the following projects and in the following amounts:

Forestry Division	\$100,000.00
Rural Fire Equipment Grants	<u>250,000.00</u>
TOTAL	\$350,000.00

SECTION 2. Funds redesignated in Section 1 of this act shall be expended for the projects and subject to the spending limits specified in this act and for no other purpose. The State

Department of Agriculture shall provide to the Office of State Finance a budget for each project specified in this act. Funds not necessary for the completion of a project specified in this act shall not be expended for any other purpose without a specific appropriation by the Legislature pursuant to Section 43 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution and Section 57.303 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The redesignation made by this act shall not be transferred as provided by the provisions of Section 41.12 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes unless specifically authorized by the Contingency Review Board.

SECTION 3. NONCODIFICATION The provisions of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
