AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 465.21, which relates to penalty for selling paint; prohibiting selling certain substances to minors and intoxicated persons; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 465.21, is amended to read as follows:

Section 465.21 Any person who knowingly sells paint containing metallic powders dispensed from a pressurized container or any glue to an obviously intoxicated person or a person under eighteen (18) years of age shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1994.
