SHORT TITLE: Oil and gas; requiring certain Corporation Commission orders to be filed with county clerks; codification; emergency.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to oil and gas; requiring certain persons to file certain orders with certain county clerks; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 87.1A of Title 52, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It shall be the duty of the applicant or any other party for whom relief is granted to file a copy of any order issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 87.1 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes with the county clerk of the county where the affected property is located. Such order must be properly filed with the said county clerk before it shall be effective and enforceable.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
