AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution declaring the month of April 1994 as Aerospace Awareness Month in the State of Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, aviation was born in Kitty Hawk, North Carolina, in 1903, and was born in Oklahoma during the same decade; and

WHEREAS, after 60 years of evolutionary development, it has become a key ingredient in our national security and a major element of our country's economy; and

WHEREAS, we cannot afford to forget those Oklahoma aviation pioneers who contributed to our nation's aviation development; and

WHEREAS, we must continue to encourage young Americans to pursue aviation careers, foster and provide assistance to our nation's key industry - Aerospace; and

WHEREAS, aviation in Oklahoma directly or indirectly employs more than 231,000 people with a \$10.2 billion payroll.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 44TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the month of April 1994 is hereby declared Aerospace Awareness Month in the State of Oklahoma.
