AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

An Act relating to courts; allowing for destruction
of certain records; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1005.1 of Title 20, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All paper records which have been microfilmed may be destroyed
after the respective case has been adjudicated. With the exception
of felony conviction records, probate, adoption, quiet title,
ejectment, partition and divorce records, all court records which
have not been microfilmed and in which no activity has occurred for
twenty-two (22) years, may be destroyed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996."
