An Act relating to prisons; amending 57 O.S. 1991,
Section 509.4, which relates to Joseph Harp
Correctional Center; deleting language; and
declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 7 through 8 1/2, strike the title to
read

"(prisons - amending 57 O.S., Sections 38 and 509.4 -
Joseph Harp Correctional Center - emergency)"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 11, strike the enacting clause

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, line 11 1/2, insert a new Section 1 to
read

"SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 1991, Section 38, as
amended by Section 1, Chapter 293, O.S.L. 1992 (57 O.S. Supp. 1994,
Section 38), is amended to read as follows:

Section 38. The Department of Corrections shall reimburse any
county, which is required to retain an inmate pursuant to paragraph
2 of Section 37 of this title, in an amount ~~not to exceed Seven
Dollars (\$7.00)~~ of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per day for each inmate
during such period of retention starting with the eleventh day after
sentencing or the day after the prisoner waives the right to appeal,
whichever is earlier. The proceeds of this reimbursement shall be

used to defray expenses of equipping and maintaining the jail and payment of personnel. The Department of Corrections shall reimburse the county for the actual costs paid for any emergency medical care for physical injury or illness of the inmate retained under this resolution if the injury or illness is directly related to the incarceration and the county is required by law to provide such care for inmates in the jail. The Director may accept any inmate required to have extended medical care upon application of the county."
