AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 7 through 8, restore the stricken
title to read

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
1991, Section 1136, as last amended by Section 1,
Chapter 194, O.S.L. 1994 (47 O.S. Supp. 1994,
Section 1136), which relates to special license
plates; providing for design of certain special
license plates; providing for certain fees;
providing for additional special license plates;
and providing an effective date."

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 14, Section 1, line 29, after the semicolon,
delete the word "and"

and on page 15, line 3, after the word "Act" and
before the period, add the language "; and"

and on page 15, line 3 1/2, add a new subsection
32 to read

"32. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road".

The fee for such plate shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the twenty-dollar fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma"
