ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 539

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commercial Feed Law;  
amending 2 O.S. 1991, Sections 8-41.3, 8-41.4, 8-  
41.5, 8-41.7, 8-41.8, 8-41.9, 8-41.11, 8-41.12 and  
8-41.15, which relate to definitions, registration  
of feed dealers and manufacturers, feed labels,  
adulteration, prohibited acts, inspection fees,  
enforcement, violations and penalties, and annual  
publication of commercial feed information; \* \* \*  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 4, Section 2, line 11, after the word "fee"  
and before the period, delete the words "of Fifty  
Dollars (\$50.00)" and insert

"established by the Board. The Board may establish an annual fee  
for licensing distributors pursuant to the provisions of the  
Oklahoma Commercial Feed Law. The maximum license fee shall not  
exceed Twenty Dollars (\$20.00), but in no case shall the fee exceed  
the reasonable costs of review and inspection services rendered by  
the Department in connection with implementing the provisions of the  
Oklahoma Commercial Feed Law. The Board shall follow the procedures

required by Article I of the Administrative Procedures Act for promulgation of rules in establishing the licensing fees."

and page 1, in the title, line 12 1/2, after the word "form;" and before the word "setting" insert the words "providing procedure for"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 9, Section 6, line 30, after the stricken word "quarter" and before the word "semi-annually" delete the words and figure "Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)" and insert the words and figure "Ten Dollars (\$10.00)"
