AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and  
entire bill and insert

An Act relating to the state militia; amending 44  
O.S. 1991, Section 41, which relates to  
organization and personnel; modifying composition;  
providing exceptions; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 1991, Section 41, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 41. The Militia of the State of Oklahoma shall consist  
of all able-bodied citizens of the United States and all other  
able-bodied persons who shall be or shall have declared their  
intentions to become citizens of the United States, who shall be  
more than seventeen (17) years of age and not more than seventy (70)  
years of age, ~~and said~~. Provided however, the Oklahoma State Guard  
and the Unorganized Militia may have persons who exceed seventy (70)

years of age if such persons are in good health. The militia shall  
be divided into three (3) classes: The National Guard, the Oklahoma  
State Guard, and the Unorganized Militia.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
