

ENGROSSED HOUSE AMENDMENTS

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 682

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68
O.S. 1991, Section 2887, which relates to ad
valorem taxes; modifying property exempt from ad
valorem taxation; clarifying language; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 7 through 9, strike the title to
read

"(revenue and taxation - amending 68 O.S., Section 2887 -
ad valorem taxes - effective date - emergency)"

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, line 12, strike the enacting clause

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, Section 1, lines 26, 31 and 32, after the
word "its" on lines 26 and 31, restore the
stricken word "facilities" and before the word
"services" on lines 26 and 32, insert the word
"or"

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 4, line 15 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to
read

"SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3106.1 of Title 68, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If the real property to be sold is listed as homestead property
on the last tax rolls, then in addition to all other notification
requirements, the county treasurer shall also cause the notice of

resale to be posted on the front door of the subject property by the county sheriff at least thirty (30) days prior to such resale. The cost of said posting shall be added to the amount necessary to redeem the property from resale or to purchase the property at resale."

and renumber subsequent sections

and when title is restored, amend accordingly
