ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 694

An Act relating to officers; amending 51 O.S. 1991, Section 6, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 127, O.S.L. 1995 (51 O.S. Supp. 1995, Section 6), which relates to dual office holding; adding an exemption to the dual office holding prohibition; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 4, line 2 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to read

"SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.1A of Title 51, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No state agency, board, commission, department or other entity of state government or any institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall employ any person who has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or who has been convicted of any felony for the sale or distribution of any drug, narcotic or controlled dangerous substance, however defined, pursuant to the laws of the jurisdiction in which the plea was entered or the conviction obtained.

B. The provisions of this section shall be applicable only to those persons seeking employment with an entity described in

subsection A of this section on or after the effective date of this act."
