An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
1991, Section 34-103, as amended by Section 2,
Chapter 285, O.S.L. 1992 (11 O.S. Supp. 1995,
Section 34-103), which relates to police
departments; authorizing municipalities to respond
to emergencies in other jurisdictions; defining
term; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 2, line 31 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to
read

"SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1991, Section 22-105, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 22-105. A. Private property may be taken for public
use, or for the purpose of giving a right-of-way or other privilege
for any necessary purpose, in the manner provided by law; but in
every case the municipality shall make adequate compensation to the
person or persons whose property shall be taken or injured thereby
as provided by law.

B. Despite any law to the contrary, in any action by a
municipality to take private property by eminent domain, evidence of
condemnation prices paid for other or adjoining tracts of land shall
be deemed competent and admissible evidence of value."
