An Act relating to schools; allowing parental
inspection of curriculum and materials used in sex
education or certain related programs or tests;
allowing optional participation in such classes or
programs; requiring certain parental notification;
allowing optional participation in certain parts of
certain courses; requiring approval by the board of
education of such curriculum and materials;
providing exceptions; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, Section 1, line 27, after the period and
before the word "The" insert the following language

"Such curriculum, class, program, test, survey or questionnaire
shall have as one of its primary and dominant purposes the teaching
and practice of abstinence."

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, Section 1, line 29, after the word
"involved" and before the word "right" delete the words
"of their" and insert the words

"in writing prior to such class or program of
such parents' or guardians'"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, Section 1, line 30, after the word
"material" and before the period insert the language

"and shall further notify such parent or guardian of their duty to
notify the school in writing if such parent or guardian objects to

his or her child's participation in such class, program, test,
survey or questionnaire"

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 1, Section 1, line 30, after the word
"shall" and before the word "participate" delete the words

"be required to"

and on line 32, after the word "attitudes" and
before the word "a" delete the word "if" and insert the
word

"until"

and on line 32, after the word "student" and
before the word "in" delete the word "objects" and insert
the word

"consents"

AMENDMENT NO. 5. Page 2, Section 1, line 13 through line 15, after
the period on line 13 and through the period on line 15,
delete all language

AMENDMENT NO. 6. Amend the title to conform as follows, Page 1,
line 11 1/2, after the word and punctuation "materials;"
and before the second word "providing" delete the words

"providing exceptions;"
