and before the word "filling", delete the word "Upon" and
insert the words

"For purposes of this study, upon"

AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, Section 1, line 10 1/2, insert a new
Section E to read as follows

"E. The State Board of Health shall report the findings of the
pilot program to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the
President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Governor by April 1,
1998."

AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 2, line 19 1/2, insert a new Section 2 to read

"SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 1991, Section 2152, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2152. Any person ~~seventeen (17)~~ sixteen (16) years of age or older shall be eligible to donate blood voluntarily without the necessity of obtaining parental permission or authorization; provided that only persons eighteen (18) years of age or older may receive compensation for blood so donated."

"An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 2152, which relates to authorizing certain persons to voluntarily donate blood; specifying purpose; establishing pilot program; providing termination date; authorizing dispensation of certain drugs in bubble pack units; providing for certain credits; providing for promulgation of rules; requiring manifest providing for contents; providing for certain report; defining terms; providing for codification; and providing an effective date."
