BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

STATE ARTS COUNCIL

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Arts
Council from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as
may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Arts
Council by law.

DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM AND RECREATION

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
Tourism and Recreation from any monies not otherwise appropriated

from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Tourism and Recreation by law.

OKLAHOMA EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION AUTHORITY

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be subject to fiscal year limitations and may be encumbered through June 30, 1996. Any unexpended funds remaining after November 15, 1996, shall lapse and be transferred to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
