AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and  
entire bill and insert

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

Short Title and Public Policy

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 51-1-101 of Title 10, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Chapter 51 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be  
known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Children's Code".

B. All statutes hereinafter enacted and codified in Chapter 51 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be considered and deemed part of the Oklahoma Children's Code.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
