An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Oklahoma Bedding Regulation Act; providing for application of act; specifying exceptions; defining terms; making certain actions unlawful; providing for promulgation of rules by the State Board of Health; specifying content; authorizing certain tagging for unlawful bedding; providing for notice, embargo, detaining and warnings; prohibiting certain removal and disposal; providing procedures; providing for final determinations; providing for lifting of embargo; providing for petitions; authorizing appeals; providing for destruction, costs and fees; authorizing corrective actions; providing for payment of certain expenses; authorizing bonds; requiring certain permits; providing for fees; requiring sanitization of certain bedding prior to sale; authorizing exceptions; requiring registration of sanitization process; requiring posting of permit; requiring maintenance of records; providing for content; providing for inspections; authorizing certain penalties for violations; authorizing inspection and collection of samples; specifying authority and

powers of Commissioner; repealing 63 O.S. 1991,
Sections 1-1001, 1-1002, 1-1003, 1-1004, 1-1005, 1-
1006, 1-1007 and 1-1008, which relate to bedding
and bedding materials; providing for codification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.
