AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the stricken title, enacting
clause and entire bill and insert

[schools - amending 70 O.S., Section 3219.1 - higher
education fees - effective date - emergency
]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 3219.1, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 3219.1 A. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher
Education may establish any special fee not specified ~~in Sections 4,~~
~~5 and 6 of this act~~ by law if the Regents determine that such fee is
necessary for academic services or other activities, facilities or
services provided by any institution of The Oklahoma State System of
Higher Education.

Within thirty (30) days of the establishment by the Regents of
such fee, the Regents shall file a report with the Speaker of the
House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate,
the Chairperson of the Higher Education Committee of the House of

Representatives and the Chairperson of the Education Committee of the Senate. The report shall specify the reasons the Regents determined such fee was necessary and any other information concerning the fee.

B. Each educational institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education shall annually publish all tuition and fees charged at that institution. The institution shall provide that publication free of charge to any person requesting any information relating to tuition or fees at that institution.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1996.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
