

ENGROSSED SENATE AMENDMENT

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2320

An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 1991, Sections 9-116, 10-111 and 11-112, which relates to compensation of municipal officers; modifying authority to compensate certain municipal officers; providing for compensation of municipal officers in charter city; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S. 1991, Sections 9-116, 10-111 and 11-112, which relate to compensation of municipal officers; modifying authority to compensate certain municipal officers; providing for compensation of municipal officers in charter city; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1991, Section 9-116, is amended to read as follows:

Section 9-116. The compensation of all elective city officers, ~~including the mayor and councilmembers,~~ shall be fixed by ordinance.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1991, Section 10-111, is amended to read as follows:

Section 10-111. ~~The mayor or other members of the city council may not receive any compensation as such or for any services rendered the city other than actual expenses~~ of all elective city officers shall be fixed by ordinance.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1991, Section 11-112, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-112. ~~The council shall determine the compensation of the mayor and acting mayor. No other councilmembers may receive any compensation as such or for any services rendered the city other than actual expenses~~ all elective city officers shall be fixed by ordinance.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 13-115 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Where a municipality has adopted a charter and the charter does not address compensation of elective city officers, the compensation of such elective city officers may be fixed by ordinance.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 1996."
