ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2981

An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
amending 59 O.S. 1991, Sections 139, 147, as  
amended by Section 11, Chapter 150, O.S.L. 1993,  
148, as amended by Section 12, Chapter 150, O.S.L.  
1993, 149 and 155 (59 O.S. Supp. 1995, Sections 147  
and 148), which relate to the Board of Podiatric  
Medical Examiners; providing for organization;  
providing time for election of officers; providing  
for duties; providing for meetings; providing  
certain compliance; providing for degree of proof;  
specifying penalties; modifying and removing  
certain grounds for penalties; providing for  
judicial review; providing for establishment of  
certain guidelines; providing for confidential  
letters for certain violations; removing outdated  
language relating to administrative procedures;  
clarifying language; creating a review panel for  
certain complaints; providing for duties and  
certain limitations; providing powers and duties;  
providing for procedures; specifying certain  
exclusions; requiring a finding; specifying  
contents; authorizing settlement agreements;  
specifying certain requirements for acceptance;

providing for use; requiring certain review and approval; modifying powers and duties of the Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners; repealing 59 O.S. 1991, Section 150, which relates to stenographic report of revocation proceedings; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 7 through 21 1/2, strike the title to read

"[ professions and occupations - Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners - effective date ]"
