AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to prisons and reformatories; restricting
uses of certain facilities; providing for codification; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 504.8 of Title 57, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Corrections shall not cause or permit any
inmate in the custody of the Department or require any offender
under the supervision of the Department to enter, remain or be
present in the facility located at 1411 North Classen Boulevard in
Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, or on grounds of the
facility for any activities involving or relating to processing,
training, instructing, interviewing, counseling, reporting,
conferring, imposing discipline, reviewing or adjudicating or any

correctional function requiring or permitting the presence of the offender, except offenders may be employed in construction, maintenance or janitorial activities in or on the structures or grounds while under supervision of a correctional employee.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
