CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund; making an appropriation to the State Board of Education; providing for midterm adjustments to State Aid to education for the 1994-95 school year; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board; requiring transfer of certain funds; making appropriations to the State Emergency Fund; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; making an appropriation to the Department of Corrections; stating purposes; making appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Six Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to the State Board of Education for supplements in State Aid to school districts for the 1994-95 school year.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for transfer to the Statewide Water Development Revolving Fund created by Section 1085.4 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of One Million Nine Hundred Ninety Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars (\$1,990,237.00) for the purpose of matching United States

Environmental Protection Agency capitalization grants for revolving loans for wastewater system improvements.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board for transfer to the Statewide Water Development Revolving Fund created by Section 1085.4 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for security and collateral for obligations issued to fund loans to eligible entities for authorized water and/or sewer purposes as provided by law.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Emergency Fund created pursuant to Section 139.42 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) as may be necessary for state emergencies.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Emergency Fund created pursuant to Section 139.42 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for costs or reimbursements associated with the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Six Million Eight Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars (\$6,828,629.00) to be expended for Medicaid costs associated with a transition to a managed care system.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Four Million Five Hundred Sixty-eight Thousand One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$4,568,160.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to

meet critical funding needs within the Oklahoma Correctional System.

SECTION 8. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 9. Section 6 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 10. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
