CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state employees and officers; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 3601, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 296, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 3601), which relates to certain limitations on numbers of full-time-equivalent state employees; changing fiscal year; updating references; modifying salary limits; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 250.4, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 250.4), which relates to state officers' salaries; modifying compensation of the Governor; amending 68 O.S. 1991, Section 102.1, as amended by Section 21, Chapter 367, O.S.L. 1992 (68 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 102.1), which relates to the compensation of members of the Oklahoma Tax Commission; modifying compensation; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 3601, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 296, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 3601), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3601. A. For purposes of Sections 3601 through 3603 of this title, the term employee means a full-time employee or any number of part-time employees whose combined weekly hours of employment equal those of a full-time employee, but shall not include temporary employees working on a seasonal basis between May 1 and October 31.

B. The maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees for each of the following agencies, boards, commissions, departments,

or programs shall not exceed the numbers specified in this section during the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1995~~ 1996, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of this title. The salary of the chief executive officer for each of the following agencies, boards, commissions, departments, or programs shall not exceed the amount specified, per annum, payable monthly, for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1995~~ 1996.

C. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System Board of Trustees by law shall be set by the said Board of Trustees. All offices, positions and personnel of the Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System shall be classified and subject to the provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration as provided in the Oklahoma Personnel Act, Section ~~840.1~~ 840-1.1 et seq. of this title, except for those offices, positions and personnel comprising the exempt unclassified service authorized in ~~Sections 840.8 and 840.10~~ Section 840-5.5 of this title; and except for one (1) other position.

D. Temporary employees of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission between the dates of November 1 and January 31 annually shall not be counted toward the maximum number of full-time-equivalent employees provided for in this section.

E. Any salary increases provided for by law for chief executive officer positions in this section shall be made regardless of any salary limitation set by this section.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 250.4, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 239, O.S.L. 1994 (74 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 250.4), is amended to read as follows:

Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of office which commences in, or after, January, ~~1995~~ 1999, the following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:

1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00)~~ equal to the salary received by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court;

2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty thousand (30,000);

3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge;

4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a district judge;

5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);

6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);

7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);

8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); and

9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a special judge.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 1991, Section 102.1, as amended by Section 21, Chapter 367, O.S.L. 1992 (68 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 102.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 102.1 A. From and after the beginning date of a term of office which commences in, or after, January, 1989, the annual compensation, payable monthly, of the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary-Member of the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be as follows:

1. For the period commencing in January, 1989, and ending in December, 1990:

2. For the period commencing in January, 1991, and ending in December, 1992:

3. For the period commencing in January, 1993, and ending in December, 1994:

Vice Chairman	\$68,132.00

4. For the period commencing in January, 1995, and ending in December, 1996:

~~4. B. For any period commencing on or after January, 1995 1997, the annual compensation of a Commissioner shall be increased by the percentage or amount provided for salary increases for employees of the Oklahoma Tax Commission for each fiscal year beginning with Fiscal Year 1995, if such employee salary increases are authorized by the Legislature Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary-Member of the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall receive a salary equal to the salary received by a Judge of the Workers' Compensation Court.~~

C. All such salaries shall be payable monthly out of monies available for expenditure for such purpose.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
