2ND CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund; making an appropriation to the State Board of Education; providing for midterm adjustments to State Aid to education for the 1994-95 school year; stating purpose; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Department on Corrections; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to the State Board of Education for supplements in State Aid to school districts for the 1994-95 school year as provided in Section 18-200 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Six Million Eight Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars (\$6,828,629.00) to be expended for Medicaid costs associated with a transition to a managed care system.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Four

Million Five Hundred Sixty-eight Thousand One Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$4,568,160.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to meet critical funding needs within the Oklahoma Correctional System.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 5. Section 2 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
