CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to torts; providing short title;  
providing for noncodification; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the  
"Tort Reform Act of 1995".

SECTION 2. NONCODIFICATION The provisions of Section 1  
of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the  
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency  
is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take  
effect and be in full force from and after its passage and  
approval.
