CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating certain public trust with the state as beneficiary thereof; authorizing the leasing of certain hospitals; authorizing the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma to contract with certain lessee; repealing 63 O.S. 1991, Section 3203, which relates to the University Hospitals Authority Act; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3230 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created a public trust of which the State of Oklahoma shall be beneficiary, which shall be named the "University Hospitals Trust".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3231 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The University Hospitals Authority, a body politic and corporate and an agency of the State of Oklahoma, created by the University Hospitals Authority Act, Section 3201 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, is hereby authorized to lease all of the Children's Hospital of Oklahoma and the University Hospital and the sites thereof to the University Hospitals Trust, a public

trust, for a term not to exceed fifty (50) years, renewable at the option of the lessee thereof for successive like terms.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3232 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The University Hospitals Authority shall cause audited reports of its operations to be delivered to the University Hospitals Trust at least annually and in addition shall report in person and in writing as often and in such detail as such trust shall from time to time direct.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3233 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma are hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the University Hospitals Trust to provide for the University Hospitals to be utilized as teaching and training hospitals for the colleges of the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center and for the College of Medicine of the University of Oklahoma, and for other health and educational activities.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3234 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The University Hospitals Trust shall submit an annual report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Such report shall be submitted by January 1 of each year and shall include an account of the operations and actions of the University Hospitals Authority and an accounting of all revenue received and disbursed by the Authority for the previous fiscal year.

B. The report shall include an accounting of expenses related to each of the following:

1. Education and training of students of the University of Oklahoma, resident physicians and others;

2. Care and treatment of indigents for whom the Authority receives any form of state or federal reimbursement; and

3. Research.

SECTION 6. REPEALER 63 O.S. 1991, Section 3203, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
