CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations; making an appropriation to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations; stating purposes; amending Sections 25 and 26 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 818 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, which relate to budgetary limitations; modifying budgetary limitations and full-time-equivalent limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

BOARD OF MEDICOLEGAL INVESTIGATIONS

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the sum of One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$117,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for one pathologist position.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 25 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 818 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 25. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 26 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 818 of the 2nd Session of the 45th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 26. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not exceed Ninety-five Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-six Dollars (\$95,696.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
