BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3207.1 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Credits earned by students in any institution of higher
education within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education where
course equivalency standards are met shall be fully accepted at any
other institution of higher education within The Oklahoma State
System of Higher Education. The State Regents shall assume
leadership in working with institutional faculty and administrators
to ensure that students move smoothly from one level of education to

another. These activities should include policies, transfer guides, degree sheets, and common course numbering.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 1995.
