An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
1991, Section 15-109, which relates to submission
of measures to voters; providing for municipal
governing body to call certain special election;
providing for certain question to be submitted at
next general election; and providing an effective
date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 1991, Section 15-109, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 15-109. Whenever a referendum is demanded against any
measure passed by the municipal governing body, or whenever an
initiative petition demands an amendment to the municipal charter,
the question shall be submitted to the registered voters of the
municipality for their approval or rejection at a special election
called by the municipal governing body for that purpose or at the
next general election, general municipal election or biennial or
special town meeting if the municipality is subject to the Oklahoma
Town Meeting Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
