(intoxicating liquors - municipalities - ordinances -
codification - effective date)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 219.1 of Title 37, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The governing board of any municipality is hereby authorized to enact ordinances which prohibit the sale of nonintoxicating beverages, as defined in paragraph (a) of Section 163.2 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for off-premises consumption between the hours of two o'clock a.m. and six o'clock a.m.

B. The governing board of any municipality is hereby authorized to enact ordinances which prohibit the sale of nonintoxicating beverages, as defined in paragraph (a) of Section 163.2 of Title 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for off-premises consumption through or at a drive-thru window.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
