An Act relating to counties and county officers;
amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 215.35A, as amended
by Section 3, Chapter 295, O.S.L. 1994 (19 O.S.
Supp. 1994, Section 215.35A), which relates to
investigators for district attorneys; modifying
certain powers; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 1991, Section 215.35A, as
amended by Section 3, Chapter 295, O.S.L. 1994 (19 O.S. Supp. 1994,
Section 215.35A), is amended to read as follows:

Section 215.35A A. Investigators for a district attorney shall
perform such services as are necessary in the investigation of
criminal activity or preparation of civil litigation within the
district at the direction of the district attorney.

B. If the district attorney's investigator is certified as a
peace officer by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
Training the investigator shall be considered a peace officer and
shall have the powers now or hereafter vested by law in peace
officers.

C. A district attorney's investigator certified as a peace
officer shall have jurisdiction in any portion of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
