(motor vehicles - amending 47 O.S., Section 153 - state-
owned unmarked automobiles - effective date)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 1991, Section 153, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 1993 (47 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 153), is amended to read as follows:

Section 153. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any state-owned automobile at any time and for any purpose, on any street or highway within this state, unless the provisions of Section 151 of this title have been strictly complied with, provided, however, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to set aside automobiles for use by the Department so that the same may be available to the Department without identifying marks thereon. These vehicles shall not be used for routine traffic enforcement but may be used to enforce traffic violations committed by motor vehicles.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
