An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 1991, Section 4-120.1, as amended by Section 20, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 1994 (26 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 4-120.1), which relates to voluntary cancellation of voter registration; prohibiting voter from reregistering for certain period of time after voluntary cancellation of registration; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 1991, Section 4-120.1, as amended by Section 20, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 1994 (26 O.S. Supp. 1994, Section 4-120.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-120.1 A registered voter may have his or her name removed from the registries of a county by executing a personally signed and notarized written notice for same to the Secretary of the State Election Board or any county election board. A voter whose name is removed from the registries of a county pursuant to this section shall not be eligible to register in the same county for three (3) months from the date the registration was voluntarily removed.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
