An Act relating to crimes and punishments;  
establishing aggravated assault and battery upon  
certain employees by an inmate as a felony;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.7 of Title 21, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Every person in the custody of the United States, a state, a  
county or city, or a federal, state, county or city contractor who,  
without justifiable or excusable cause, commits any aggravated  
assault and battery upon the person of an employee of the United  
States, a state, a county or city, or a federal, state, county or  
city contractor while that employee is in the performance of the  
employee's official duties, shall upon conviction thereof be guilty  
of a felony.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
