

ENGROSSED HOUSE

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 1991,  
Section 14-105, which relates to courses and  
training provided by the State Department of  
Vocational and Technical Education; clarifying  
statutory language; providing an effective date;  
and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 1991, Section 14-105, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 14-105. The State Department of Vocational and  
Technical Education may operate and maintain, or otherwise provide  
for, courses of instruction and training in vocational and technical  
education courses and subjects, and charge students reasonable  
tuition fees for ~~such~~ instruction or training. The fees shall be  
deposited in a special fund, which is hereby created, to be known as  
the State Vocational-Technical Fund. The fund may be used to pay  
expenses incurred by the Department in operating and maintaining  
~~such~~ the classes, and payment therefrom may be upon vouchers signed  
by a person or persons designated by the State Board of Vocational  
and Technical Education. The fund may also be used for the

operation of the ~~Mid-America~~ Multistate Academic and Vocational Curriculum Consortium (MAVCC) for the purpose of developing and disseminating curriculum materials for the member states.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
