

ENGROSSED HOUSE
BILL NO. 1469

An Act relating to banks and trust companies;
amending 6 O.S. 1991, Section 2115, which relates
to the Sale of Checks Act; providing for certain
money order companies to stop payment on certain
money orders; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 6 O.S. 1991, Section 2115, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 2115. A. Each licensee may conduct ~~his~~ business at
such locations within this state and through or by means of such
employees, agents, subagents or representatives as ~~he~~ the licensee
may from time to time designate and appoint, so long as the
Commissioner has been notified timely of each location, appropriate
licensing fees have been paid, and the bonding requirement has been
met.

B. A company that issues a money order and which is governed by
the Sale of Checks Act may stop payment on a money order drawn on

the account of the money order company pursuant to Section 4-403 of
Title 12A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
