An Act relating to statutes and reports; requiring identification of rules with unacceptable financial impact; requiring state government entities to make report; requiring cooperation with cabinet secretaries; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. A. On or before October 1, 1995, each cabinet secretary shall review or cause to have reviewed administrative rules within the cabinet secretary's cabinet department, including those that are not part of the Oklahoma Administrative Code, which should be modified or repealed because of their unacceptable financial impact upon the private sector in Oklahoma. Each cabinet secretary shall report the rules which the cabinet secretary determines should be modified or repealed, along with a cost benefit estimate, if practicable, to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

B. All state agencies, boards, and commissions in a cabinet secretary's cabinet department shall cooperate with the cabinet

secretary in conducting the review required by subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. NONCODIFICATION The provisions of Section 1 of this act shall not be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
