An Act relating to motor vehicles; authorizing the
Commissioner of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
Services to set aside certain vehicles; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 153.1 of Title 47, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and
Substance Abuse Services is hereby authorized to set aside
automobiles for the use of the Department without identifying marks.
These vehicles may be used to provide client services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1995.
