(Oklahoma State Department of Health - duties and
compensation of employees - effective date - emergency
)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Department of Health by law shall be set by the Commissioner of Health. The salary of the Commissioner shall not exceed Ninety-five Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$95,620.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Oklahoma State Department of Health for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects and intra-agency transfers, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
