BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services by law shall be set by the Commissioner. The salary of the Commissioner shall not exceed Ninety Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-six Dollars (\$90,926.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
