(University Hospitals Authority - duties and compensation
of employees - effective date - emergency)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the University Hospitals Authority by law shall be set by the Authority. The salary of the Administrator of the University Hospitals shall not exceed One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996. The University Hospitals Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special projects except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
