BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the amount of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the salaries, per diem, and expenses of the members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the salaries of the employees of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and other necessary expenses. Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriation made to the House of Representatives for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, shall be approved by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____

Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase of Oklahoma Statutes, Session Laws, and supplements.

LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Senate from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1996, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed on the State Senate by law.

SECTION 5. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1995.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
